## Physical Distancing Tools for Concrete Producers

Over the past few weeks, members have been developing a number of highly effective tools to assist their employee's with physical distancing and to adjust industry practices that relate to reducing the spread of COVID-19. With the help of our fellow associations, our committees and information shared by our members we have developed the attached support documents:

- A sample sticker/window sign that reminds people to be mindful of physical distancing. The **Stop and Stay 2 metres from the Driver & Concrete Truck** sticker was initially developed by Concrete BC and is used with their permission.
- Two sample posters that members can use to remind their customers that they need to maintain a minimum 2 metres distance between the driver and the concrete truck on jobsites.
- A sample warning poster that can be displayed near entrance ways at all concrete plant facilities, reminding people that active concrete plants are currently off limits to external visitors who have not already made prior arrangements with the company to schedule a plant visit.
- A sample visitor questionnaire, in a fillable PDF format, that can be sent to anyone that plans to visit a concrete plant. The objective of the electronic questionnaire is to address the four primary survey questions, without having to pass paper copies between personnel to minimize the potential for touching contaminated documents.



Various members have implemented many new and innovative systems and we thank them for sharing their safety best practise with our industry. These documents have been developed by the safety committee for the use of all our members as resource materials that can be used as is or modified to fit individual company/workplace needs and policies.
