- Reporting to the Mobile Equipment Maintenance Superintendent, the Fleet Maintenance Supervisor – Afternoon/Evening, is responsible for the scheduling and supervision of fleet maintenance repairs to ensure maximum fleet availability
- Contribute to the overall efficiency and productivity of our ready mix operations through effective preventative and corrective maintenance programs
- Ensure Environmental and Health & Safety standards are met.
- Assist in maintaining a safe and clean work environment in all garages.
- Ensure all fleet vehicles are in a safe road worthiness state.
- Co-ordinate and monitor preventative maintenance, major repairs, daily running repair issues and maintain the availability by scheduling repairs in accordance with established budget and production demands.
